## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

- Child's legal birth certificate.
- If the parents are not registered members of St. John Bosco or do not reside within the parish boundaries, must submit a letter from their parish giving them permission to baptize their child in this parish.
- It is mandatory that parents and godparents attend a pre-baptism class. Pre-baptismal classes are held the first and third Friday of each month at 7:45 pm, in the Parish Hall and last approximately one hour. They are normally taught in Spanish. It is strictly forbidden to bring children to the class; if you do so, you will not be allowed to stay.
- If any parent practice another religion which is not the Catholic religion, the applicant must submit a notarized letter signed by the non-Catholic parent giving his/her consent for the child to be baptized in the Catholic faith.
- If the parents are separated or divorced, and one will not attend the Baptism. The applicant must submit a notarized letter signed by the other party, giving consent for the child to be baptize in the Catholic faith.
- Baptism are celebrated on the second and fourth Saturday of each month at 12:00 noon.
- The godparents must be practicing Catholics (Read these requirements on the reverse).
- All documents must be submitted three weeks prior to the date of the Baptism.

### **DONATION**

Although all of the sacraments administered by the Catholic Church are free of charge, it is suggested a minimum donation of \$50.00 for each child, which must be paid at the Parish Office when you bring the required documents. The donation for a private baptism is \$250.00 for registered parishioners, and must also be delivered in the same way. For those who are not registered parishioners, or live outside of the Parish boundaries the donation will be \$500.00 All donations help the mission and maintenance of the Parish.

# REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS

- 1. Sponsors are chosen by the parents of the candidate. (Can. 874.1).
- 2. The godparents must be practicing Catholics attend mass frequently, be registered in a parish and comply with the teachings of the Catholic faith (Can. 874.1).
- 3. Must have all the Sacraments: Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation (Can. 874.1.3, 874.1.4, 874,1,5).
- 4. If either Godparent is married, must be married in the Catholic Church.
- 5. Must be at least 16 years old. (Can. 874.1.2).
- 6. Sponsors cannot be the parents of the candidate, nor adoptive parents.
- 7. Cannot be sponsors if they do not have the intentions of complying with the obligations required by our Catholic Church ensure training, direction and education of the Catholic faith of the candidate.
- 8. Godparents/sponsors are not people who have any type of impediment to practice the Catholic Faith.
